



Ministerial Code of Ethics

- A. The New Thought Minister operates under the affiliation of ENTC for the purpose of practicing and disseminating the principles, processes and procedures of New Thought and Ancient Wisdom.
- B. Minister's work is done entirely in mind and heart.
- C. A Minister does spiritual counseling only and is not qualified to be a therapist unless licensed by the state in which he/she resides.
- D. A Minister does not denigrate the work of another minister, practitioner or Center.
- E. The relationship between a Minister and client is one of confidence and trust and is held inviolate. The private affairs of a client are never divulged, nor are a case discussed in a way that would identify the client.
- F. A Minister advertises at his/her own discretion using personal cards, listings in a church bulletin, New Thought publications and announcements in local papers with wording acceptable to ENTC.
