



Practitioner Code of Ethics

- A. The New Thought Practitioner operates under the authority and license granted by ENTC for the purpose of practicing and disseminating the principles, processes and procedures of New Thought and Ancient Wisdom and acts in a manner reflecting such principles.
- B. A Practitioner's work is done entirely in mind and heart.
- C. A Practitioner does not counsel or give advice.
- D. A Practitioner does not solicit a client.
- E. A Practitioner does not denigrate the work of another Practitioner, Minister or Center.
- F. The relationship between a Practitioner and client is one of confidence and trust and is held inviolate. The private affairs of a client are never divulged, nor is a case discussed in a way that would identify the client.
- G. A Practitioner advertises at his/her own discretion using personal cards, listings in a church bulletin, New Thought publications and announcements in local papers with wording acceptable to ENTC.
- H. A Practitioner financially supports and actively participates in the ongoing growth of ENTC.
